
Expand our strengths and leap into the world




Euphonia ayano Onishi



"The age of aviation is coming" - the starting point of aviation education as dreamed by the founder

In 1932, which can be said to be the dawn of the aviation industry in Japan, the "Aviation Engine Training Center", the parent of the Japan Aviation College, was opened. When Mr. Yoshizo Umezawa, the founder of the Japan Aviation College, was a university student in Tokyo, he happened to see a "flying machine", which was still very rare at the time, and learned that it was an airplane. The founder's strong belief and passion that "the age of aviation is coming" established the foundation that leads to today's school education.
